This semester, though, I am happy to be a tutor of Latin/French/Spanish and a French translator intern with a Canadian educational organization.

Next, thank you for writing my recommendation for the professional phase of the Middle and Secondary Education in French major at UofL. I was accepted and will continue my coursework and field experiences next spring. I am excited to be a future French teacher in Kentucky, as I plan on teaching for a while before going to graduate school in French linguistics. With an interest in researching French language learning and teaching, the pedagogical training of an education major will inform much of what I will do and publish.
