How to Fill a Prescription:



- Your doctor will send your medicine to the **pharmacy** that you pick (Walmart, Walgreens, Publix...).
- If the pharmacy has your phone number, they will call you when your medicine is ready. If they don't have your phone number, you can call the next day and ask if it is ready.
- When you call, say, "Is my prescription ready?" They will ask for your name. They might also ask for your birthday, address, or phone number.
- When your prescription is ready, go to the pharmacy and say, "I'm here to pick up a prescription." They will ask for your name and most likely your birthday and address.
