Hello all,

Good news! The Center for Literacy received notification that we received \$4K for our Youth Literacy outreach opportunities through EDU 250 and other undergraduate teacher prep programming. This is great news, as last year, they gifted us \$2000, and I am viewing this increase in amount as proof that they valued the work we did last year with our grant monies.

I need to put aside about \$500 for the literacy clinic with Dr. Hulan, but that leaves us \$1750 to spend on youth literacy this fall and spring semester each. For the fall, if we all take advantage of it, that works out to around \$220 per EDU 250 class section.

If you would, let me know if you are interested in using any of these funds in the next week or so. Last year, Melissa, Catherine, and I provided pizza, books, and activities for Rich Pond, and I know we have a few more schools targeted for this fall. Soyoung did a similar event at Parker Bennett Curry in the spring. I can provide direction and suggestions for how the funding can be used within the confines of the grant. Conversely, if you know you aren't going to use it this fall, I'd appreciate it also if you would let me know that so that the money can be redistributed among the others.
