It is a Quizziz quiz. You will need to make an account to take the test, but it is free and will prompt you to do so when you click the link.

This quiz is in a very different format than the other quizzes we have taken. It is entirely multiple choice. There are 25 questions. It is also timed. You will have one minute max per question, so if you do not answer before time runs out, it will automatically move to the next question.

I will send another email later this week, but Evidence Guide #2 is still due on Monday.

Next Wednesday, we'll have a quiz over chapters 4 & 5 of The Hunger Games, and we'll discuss the first five chapters.
