

The purpose of this assignment is to provide evidence of your capstone project and how it has impacted you and your professional setting.

Students are expected to present to their small group and professor (preferably live, whether in-person or via Zoom). The presentation should NOT be longer than 15 minutes nor shorter than 8 minutes.

Presentations must include the following areas:

1. Description of the goal of your capstone project. Incorporate information from your prospectus and action plan as appropriate.
2. Discuss activities that were chosen and why (use research support). Specifically focus on how these **demonstrated your expertise and knowledge that culminated in this Capstone project.**
3. Use data to describe the progress of the activities and how successful the activities were in both execution and contribution to project goal. Incorporate some information from your activities' reflections/post surveys/data collection.
4. Discuss what your next steps are in meeting the goal or what you would revise if you had to do the project over (incorporation post-survey/interview data, as appropriate).

In addition to the presentations, students are REQUIRED to give feedback on their fellow group members' presentations. The in-person reflection should include:

Description of the activities and your personal thoughts on how they could have been improved or what you may have done differently.

Overall opinion on whether or not the classmate was successful.
