Melissa,

For those without an undergraduate degree in education, this one is often the toughest to crack, but it's really not too hard.

We'll start by looking at your two objectives.

Content - Ninth grade students will evaluate the use of the Mercator projections to display spatial data and answer the question how does the map-maker's intent influence which map projection to use scoring at least proficient on the assessment rubric.

Tech - Ninth grade students will create an online infographic to present their findings to the class scoring a proficient or better on the assessment rubric.

Let's start with content by going to the Kentucky Standards. <https://kystandards.org/> Since you are dealing with a Mercator projection, Science is probably our best place to start. However, I looked through those, and there aren't really any at the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level that will fit well. We'll try Social Studies next. I'm literally doing a Ctrl+F for Map, but if this doesn't pan out, we can also look for a standard about the practices of evaluating.

One Social Studies standard that I think you could justify using, which isn't a perfect fit, is this one: HS.G.GR.1 Interpret the relationships among human and physical patterns and processes at local, national and global scales.

I think you can make the case that this standard can fit, and I am fine with you using that one. You could also go into ELA and look for some high school standards involving evaluation. Does this help?

For your tech standard, we're probably better off going to the ISTE and AASL standards. We're talking about using technology to organize information here. I am going to point you to the ISTE Standards: Coaches (that's the ones we use in the Libraries, Informatics, and Technology in Education program) here: <https://www.iste.org/standards/iste-standards-for-coaches>

Each of those standards can be clicked and expanded into smaller standard. You could just select one, such as 4.4.a to fit. I'm going to let you tackle this one, but please let me know if you need more guidance!
