

# Podcast Assignment

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## AI Ethics Podcast

### Overview:

Students will produce an **8–10 minute podcast episode** discussing a major ethical concern related to AI and education. The podcast should be **engaging, well-researched, and designed for educators, students, or parents.**

### Steps to Complete:

#### 1. Choose a Topic:

- AI Bias in Schools
- Data Privacy & Student Rights
- Misinformation & AI
- Ethical AI Use for Educators
- AI's Role in Student Discipline & Grading

#### 2. Podcast Format:

- **Solo Podcast:** A structured, narrative-style episode explaining the issue and potential solutions.
- **Interview:** Feature an expert, teacher, librarian, or administrator discussing AI ethics.
- **Roundtable Discussion:** A conversation with classmates (optional) analyzing an ethical dilemma. [If 2-3 of you from class wish to get together and do this as a pair of small group, that is acceptable! Email me for more information.]

#### 3. Content Requirements:

- Explain the chosen issue with **real-world examples.**
- Reference at least **two credible sources** (ISTE, Dept. of Education, case studies, etc.).
- Provide **practical recommendations** for ethical AI use in schools.

#### 4. Production & Submission:

- Record using tools like **Audacity, GarageBand, Anchor, or Zoom.**
- Export as **MP3 or WAV** file. You may also do a video podcast and submit the exported MP4 video file.
- Upload to Blackboard or share a link to the hosted file (Google Drive, YouTube, etc.).
  - With your file or link upload, also submit a document that contains your APA references from your research.

# Rubric for AI Ethics Podcast (100 Points)

<b>Content Depth (30 pts)</b>	Well-researched, insightful, and covers ethical issues thoroughly. Uses at least two credible sources.	Good research, covers key points but lacks depth in areas.
