Thank you for expressing interest in the Study Abroad program to the United Kingdom in Summer 2026! This immersive experience offers you the chance to explore a fascinating country while earning credit for all of your required WKU's Colonnade Connections courses:

- LME 448 will fulfill the Global to Local requirement.
- ID 475 will count for the Systems requirement.
- EDU 400 will meet the International Experience requirement.

You can take one, two or three of these courses and be a part of the experience.

This program will be led by Dr. Andi Paganelli (who visited Harlaxton with another Study Abroad group) and Dr. Jeremy Logsdon, who will also be your professors for these courses.

Our tentative itinerary includes exciting academic and cultural opportunities:

- Stay at the historic Harlaxton Manor, with a welcome dinner, lectures, and local tours.

- Visit iconic sites like St. Wulfram's Church and Trigge Chained Library, and Cambridge University.
- Engage with UK education systems through school observations and university visits.
- Explore the vibrant city of London, including a guided tour of the Ragged Museum, Foundling Museum, Harrow School, and enjoy some independent exploration time.

The program runs from July 5–July 17, 2026, and is designed to enrich your academic journey while broadening your global perspective.
