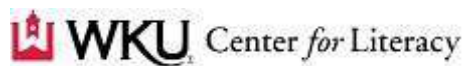

Dr. Logsdon,

Thank you so much for offering me these materials and services. When talking with my mom, she spoke very highly of you and knew you would be a great person to help me out! I have struggled with the PRAXIS Core Math since May, and I'm grateful WKU has these resources that UK lacks.

Little background: I'm a junior here at UK, studying Special Education. The College of Ed has you apply for TEP (Teacher Education Program), and I have to be admitted into this program to finish my last three semesters. They take your ACT scores for Reading, Writing, and Math, and you have to meet a certain score in each subject to be admitted, as well as interview for the program. My Math ACT was a 16, and for program admission, I needed a 22. To replace that score, they have me taking the PRAXIS Core Math 5733. I have taken the PRAXIS Core Math 4 times. I have come within 6 points of passing twice. The minimum score I need is a 139. The College of Ed gives you a 5-point boost if you have a GPA higher than 3.0, which I do. I last took the PRAXIS on October 4th and received a 126, and am now in that 28-day waiting period, and can take the test as early as November 2nd. After speaking with some high-ups at my college, if I fail to pass this by the end of our semester, I will be set back an entire year in college. I wouldn't continue with my major next semester since all classes are within the TEP. I would have to pick up a minor and spend a year on that, then apply for TEP and interview again this time next year, which is definitely not my desired outcome. So, here I am. (Sorry, this is a lot of info.)

The 7-8 (Eastern Time) tutoring on Zoom timeframe works perfectly for me! On Monday's I have a 4-6:30 class, so I love that it fits my schedule! I will be in town for my fall break on October 27-28 and would be happy to come in person that Monday night if you all are available.

I do have Respondus Lockdown installed already on my MacBook and am familiar with Blackboard! I will log on today and take a practice test to give you all a baseline score. I'm also happy to provide the tutor with my previous score reports. Today, I am creating a Study.com account and also using some additional study resources that my college has provided me previously.

Again, thank you so much for your time and resources. I am beyond grateful for you all!
